TITLE: After school program teacher at Bolger Middle School for 21st CCLC program (KAP)

STIPEND: \$32 per hour x 125 hours for certified staff. Stipend not to exceed \$4,000. Position funded through the 21st CCLC grant.

JOB DESCRIPTION:

- Supervise homework help and develop and facilitate hands-on math remediation lessons for grades 6/7 middle school students from 2:45-3:45 on Mondays and Wednesdays.
