We are pleased to inform you that Keansburg School District will be implementing a new option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for School Year 2020-2021.

All enrolled students of Keansburg School District implementing CEP are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the 2020-2021 school year.

This letter is to inform you that your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit an application.

You may be asked to complete a Household Information Survey. **Your participation is essential in order for us to provide the Department of Education with the information it needs to ensure our school district will continue to receive critical state funding.**
