# We are growing!



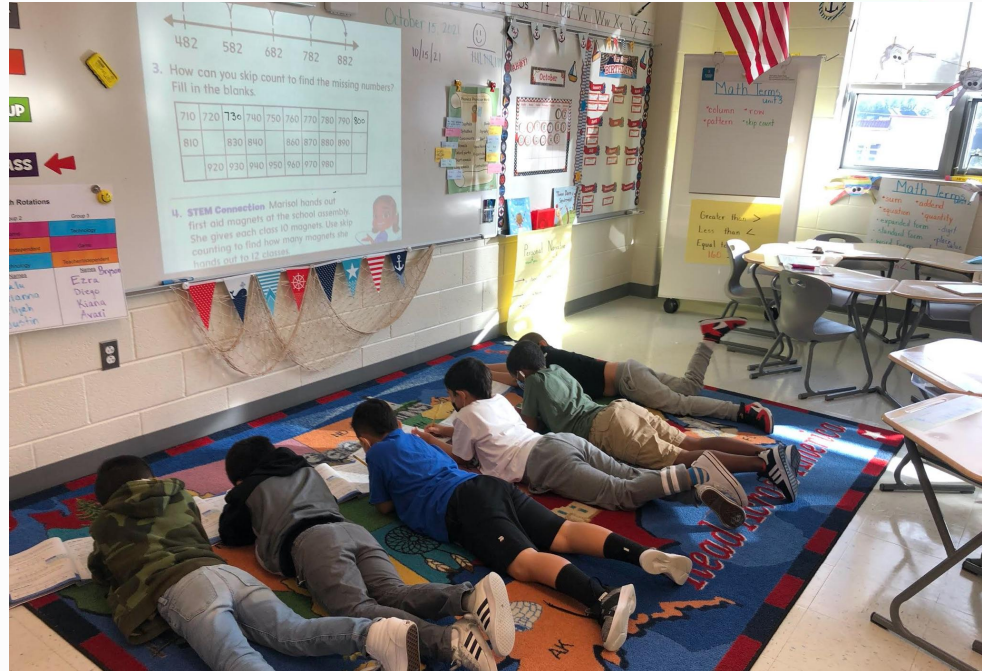
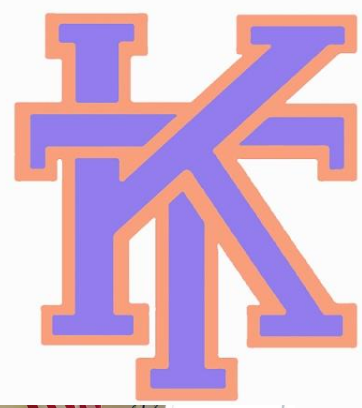
- Current student enrollment is 708 students

- Academic Loss Specialists are using data to provide classroom interventions

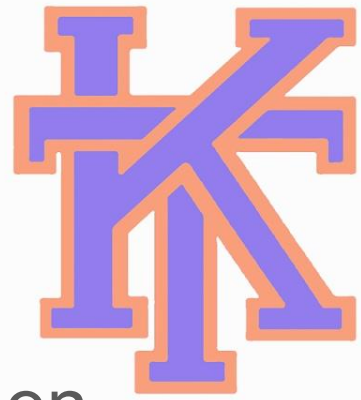

NORTH ELEVATION - SIDE VIEW

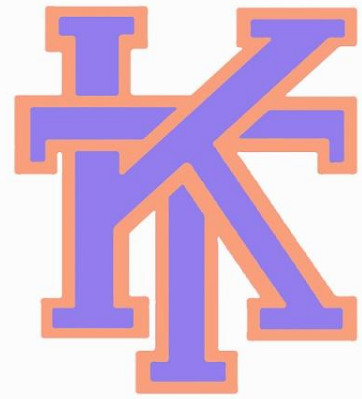

# Dynamic Learning Maps Assessment



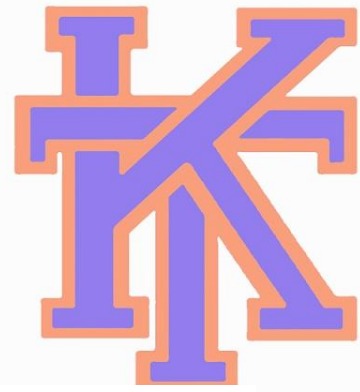

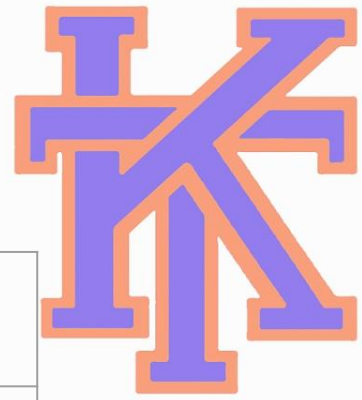

# ACCESS for ELLs



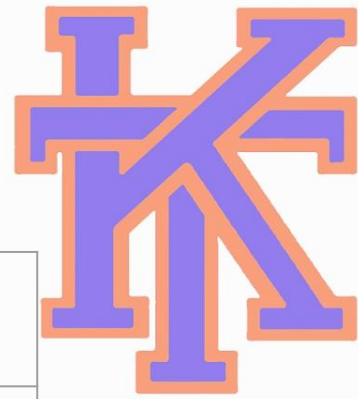
- Is an English language proficiency assessment for students in Kindergarten through Grade 12
- It is given every year to students who are English Language Learners
- It monitors the English language development of students
- It measures students' language proficiency every year (Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing, Oral language, Literacy & Comprehension).
- Proficiency level scores are reported from 1.0 (beginner) to 6.0 (advanced).
- For students in grades K through 12, an Access for ELLs proficiency level of 4.5 or higher is required for exiting the program.
- The district had 50 students test.

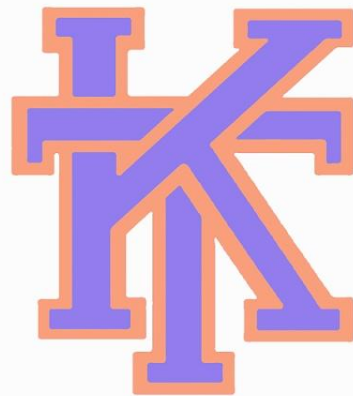

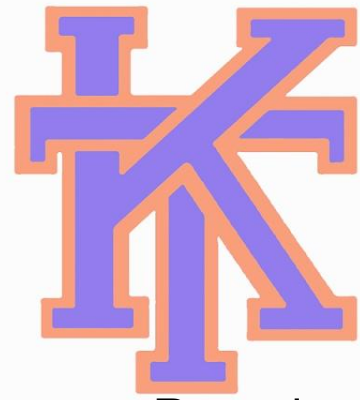


# Next Steps



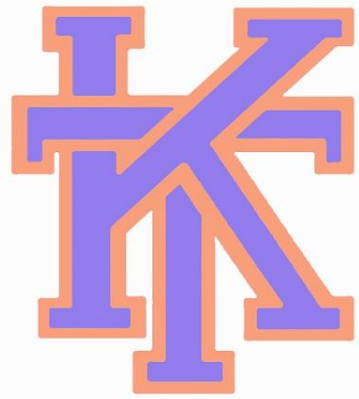
- English Language Learner Three-Year Program Plans 2021-2024 on January 31st
  - Every three years school districts must submit a plan describing their district's program for English language learners (ELLs).
  - The plan is an opportunity for educators to review the academic needs of their ELLs and the type of language assistance program and academic environment that would best address those needs.

# Assessment and Instruction



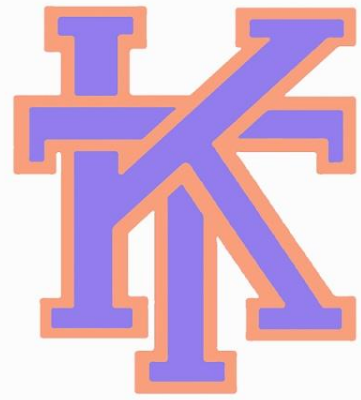
- K-8 Teachers have started the implementation of a new math program Reveal
- Preschool Teachers have started the implementation of the Tools of the Mind Curriculum
- Benchmark Form A has been administered district wide
  - Students will take the benchmark three times throughout the year
- Start Strong testing was completed on 10/22 scores will be available in the upcoming weeks
- New approved NJSLA Standards in specific areas will be implemented September 2022

# Academic Support and Enrichment



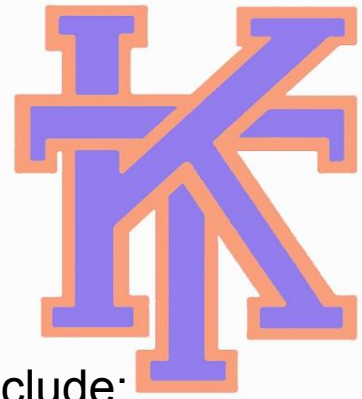
- WIN periods at the Middle School and High School
  - Identified students will have the opportunity to receive a built in period of support or enrichment rather than pulling them from content instruction
- Academic Loss Specialists
  - Extra support for identified students in grades K-5
  - Small group instruction with specialist

# Technology



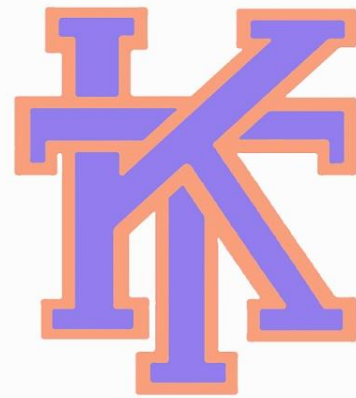
- All students are 1:1 with chromebooks K-12
