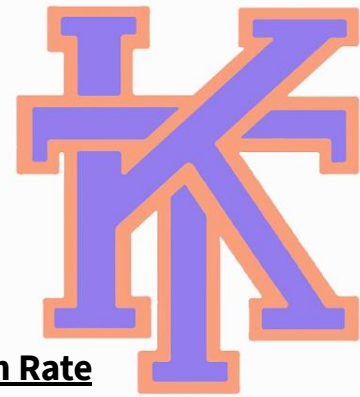
Graduation Data

2019-2020

KHS Class of 2020

- 114 Students
- 100 Graduates (including 2 appeals)
- Graduation Rate: 86% (87.72 with appeals)
- 14 Students in-district between 1-2 years
- 3 Students in-district less than one year
- (State Average 90.2)

Graduation Data Continue

- Out of the 17 Students from the grouping of being here less than a year to two years, 12 graduated and five did not.
- Graduation Rate for 1-2 year students is 71.4 %.
- Graduation Rate for homeless students is 50 %.
 - Two total and one graduated.

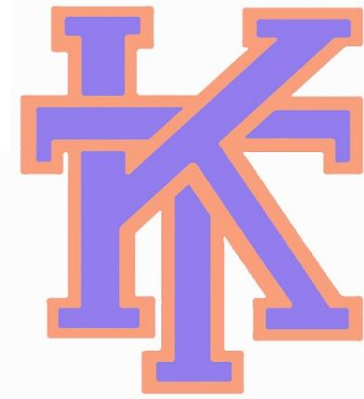
Four Year Graduation Rate

- **Class of 17: 81.7%**
- **Class of 18: 79.5 %**
- **Class of 19: 87.9 %**
- **Class of 20: 87.7% (87.2% w/appeals)**

- **Class of 18: 87.7%**
- **Class of 19: 88.1%**

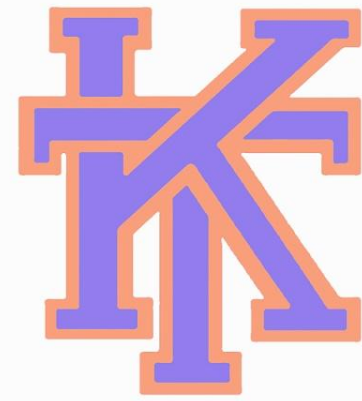

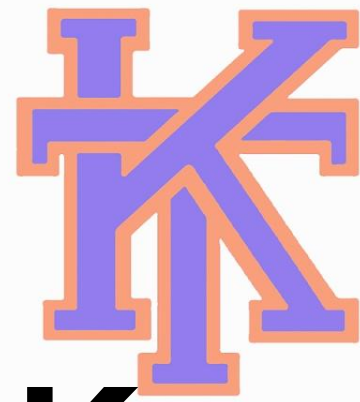




Looking Ahead

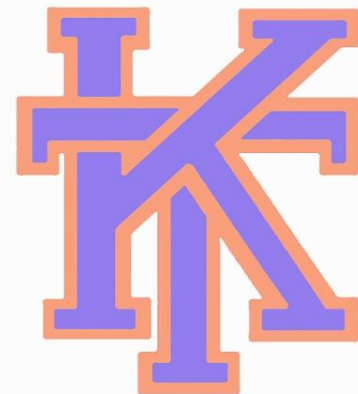
PORT MONMOUTH ROAD SCHOOL

NORTH ELEVATION - SIDE VIEW



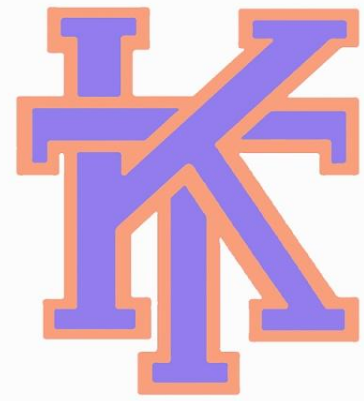

ACCESS for ELLs



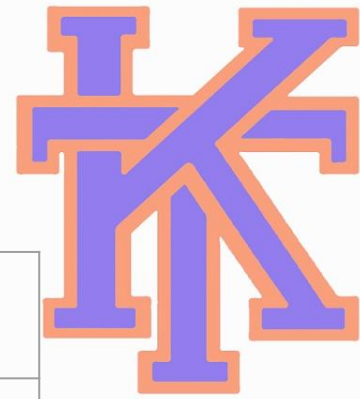
- An English language proficiency assessment for students in Kindergarten through Grade 12
- Given every year to students who are English Language Learners
- Monitors the English language development of students
- Measures students' language proficiency every year.
- Proficiency level scores are reported from 1.0 (beginner) to 6.0 (advanced).

2019-2020 Scores (Elementary)



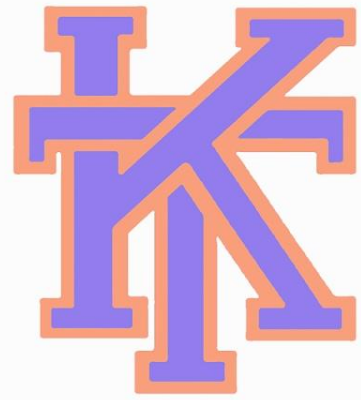

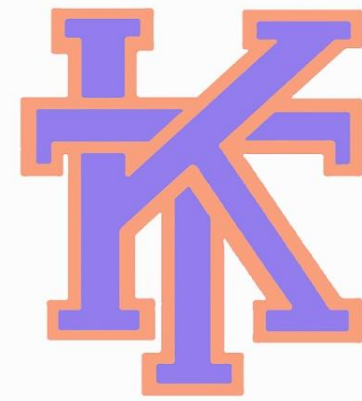
