**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the provisions of the Public Schools Contract Law, N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-22, the Keansburg Board of Education has determined that the bids received do not conform to the specifications for the one or more of the following reasons:

- Ø the lowest bid substantially exceeds the cost estimates
- Ø the lowest bid substantially exceeds the board of education's appropriation
- Ø the board of education had decided to abandon the project
- Ø the board of education wants to substantially revise the specifications
- Ø the purpose or provision or both of N.J.S.18A:18A-1 et seq. are being violated
- Ø the board of education had decided to use the State authorized contract pursuant to N.J.S. 18A:18A-10;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Keansburg Board of Education rejects all proposals for the After School Instructional Support Program.
